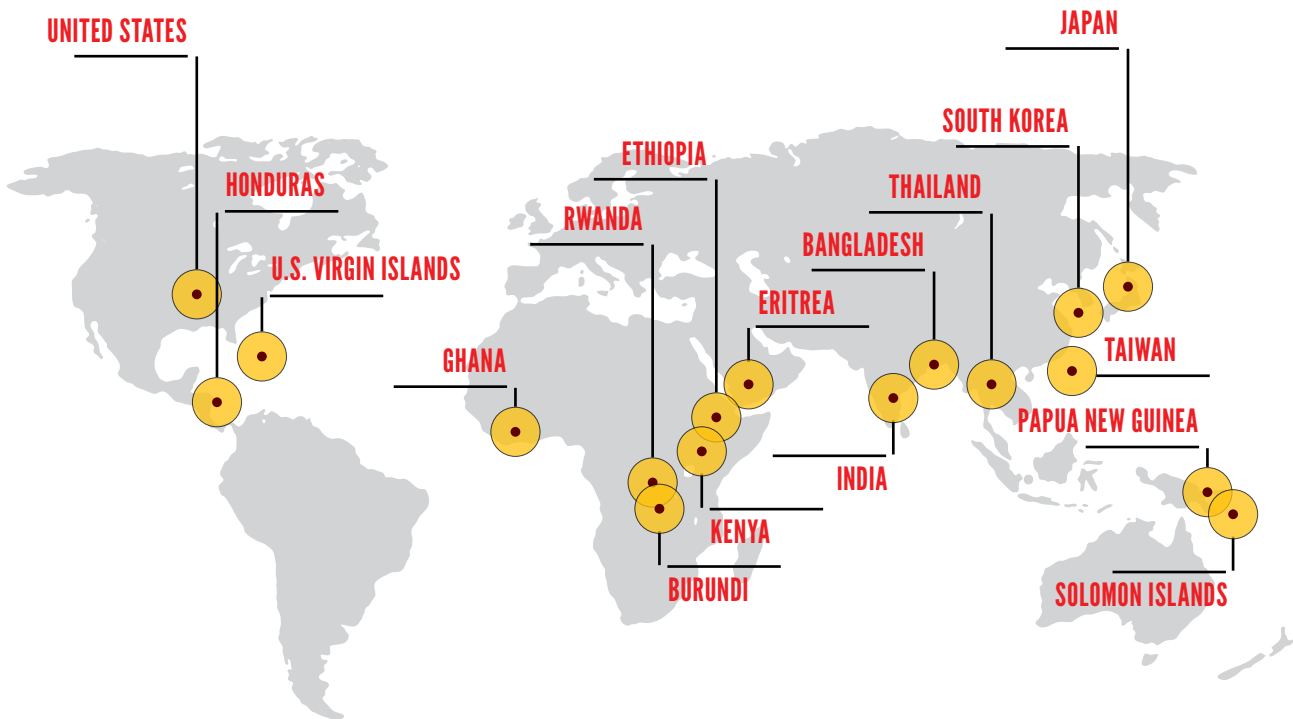

08**LIFELONG FRIENDSHIPS.**

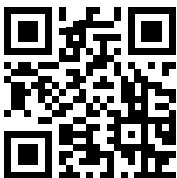
Former students often talk about the friendships begun while attending Mt. Carmel that remain strong today. As a boarding school, Mt. Carmel creates a bond that is like family.
