4. How mature/self-reliant is your child? Can you provide examples to illustrate maturity or lack of maturity?

5. How well is your child able to monitor/control his or her behavior during times of stress or extreme emotion?

6. How easily does your child become angry and how is that anger expressed?

7. What is the most serious disciplinary incident that your child has been involved in at school? What were the results of this incident? When did it occur?

8. What are your child's current grades? Are these similar to grades earned in the past few years? What does your child need to do in order to improve his/her achievement in school?

9. Approximately how many days of school did your child miss last year? What were the reasons for the absences?

10. Has your child ever been diagnosed with a learning disability? Even if not diagnosed, do you suspect that your child has a learning disability?

11. What medicines does your child currently take? Does your child have any health problems that may affect their life at Mt. Carmel?

12. Has your child ever been treated/diagnosed with a mental illness or emotional disorder? Has your child ever threatened to hurt himself/herself or others? If so, what was the result?

13. Has your child ever been involved with police or the juvenile court system? If so, please explain.

14. How easily does your child make friends? Do you feel that your child makes wise choices in their friendships with peers?

15. Please describe any problems/confrontations that have arisen concerning your child and his/her interactions with the opposite sex. Is your child currently dating?

16. How well does your child get along with peers or siblings? Has your child been involved in a physical fight within the past three years? If so, what were the circumstances?
