SECTION FIVE: PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT AND AGREEMENTS

1. *Publicity and Advertisement Waiver*

Mt. Carmel School uses pictures of current and former students in advertisements and brochures prepared for the school. Pictures may also be used in newspaper articles about the school. The use of these pictures enables us to design attractive publications to spread the word about the opportunities provided by our school.

2. *Asbestos/Pesticide Notification*

All school buildings used by this local education agency have been inspected for asbestos and a management plan developed for any asbestos containing material found during the inspection. The management plan is available for inspection during normal business hours by representatives of EPA, the state, and the public, including teachers, other school personnel and their representatives, and parents. A reasonable charge will be made for copies. The school system provides pest control as part of its health services for the school community. A recent change in state regulations now requires that the school give a 24-hour notice prior to any pest control applications made on school property. This information is available to all parents and employees requesting it. Those individuals applying pesticides will be properly certified in keeping with applicable legal requirements for the IPM program.

3. *Activities Permission*

During the school year, students will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of off-campus trips and activities. These include field trips that are taken during the school day as well as extracurricular activities that take place after school hours. All of these events are chaperoned and students are transported in school vehicles with qualified drivers.

Mt. Carmel School provides students with the opportunity to participate in varsity sports. This participation requires an additional fee that must be paid at the beginning of the year. Students who sign up for team sports and then cannot participate for some reason will receive a full refund if they withdraw from the sport before the season begins.

4. Personal Electronics Policy
